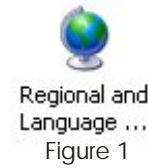


# Adding Spanish Keyboard Settings to Windows XP

1. Open the control panel  
(Click the “Start” Button - Click on Control Panel)

2. Double-click “Regional and Language Options” (See figure 1)



3. Click the “Languages” Tab at the top of the window (See figure 2)

4. Click the “Details” Button (See figure 3)

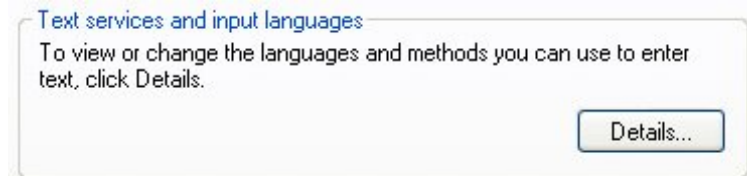
