After two years of data-informed discussions regarding the revision of the College's mission, vision, and values, including multiple mini-retreats, open forums, and input-gathering through feedback forms, which included members of the faculty, classified staff, students, and administrators, the College Council reached a consensus regarding revisions to the College's mission, vision, and values on April 27, 2021. Based on all the information gathered over the past two years, including the criteria the College Council established for this revision process in 2018 as well as ACCJC accreditation standards, as well as dialog in the College Council, the Council recommends the following revisions to the College's mission statement, vision statement, and values:

Recommendation for the College Mission Statement:
