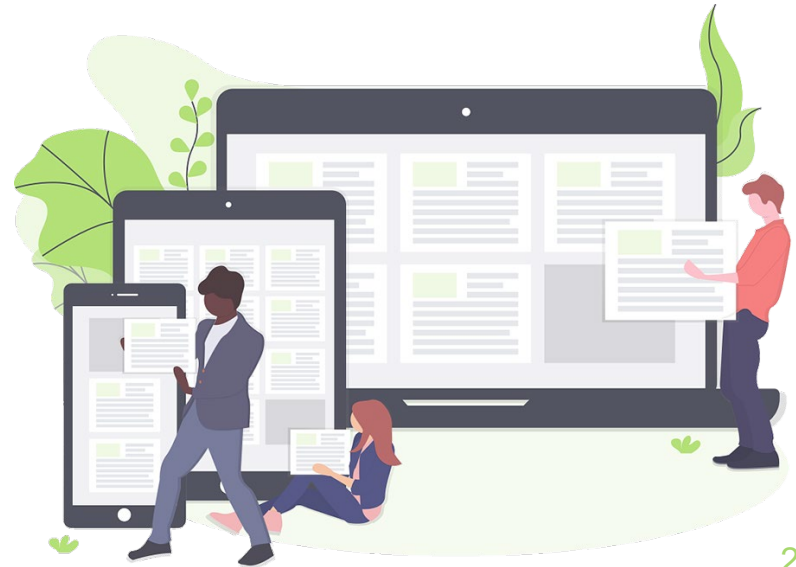

Purpose of Course Exchange

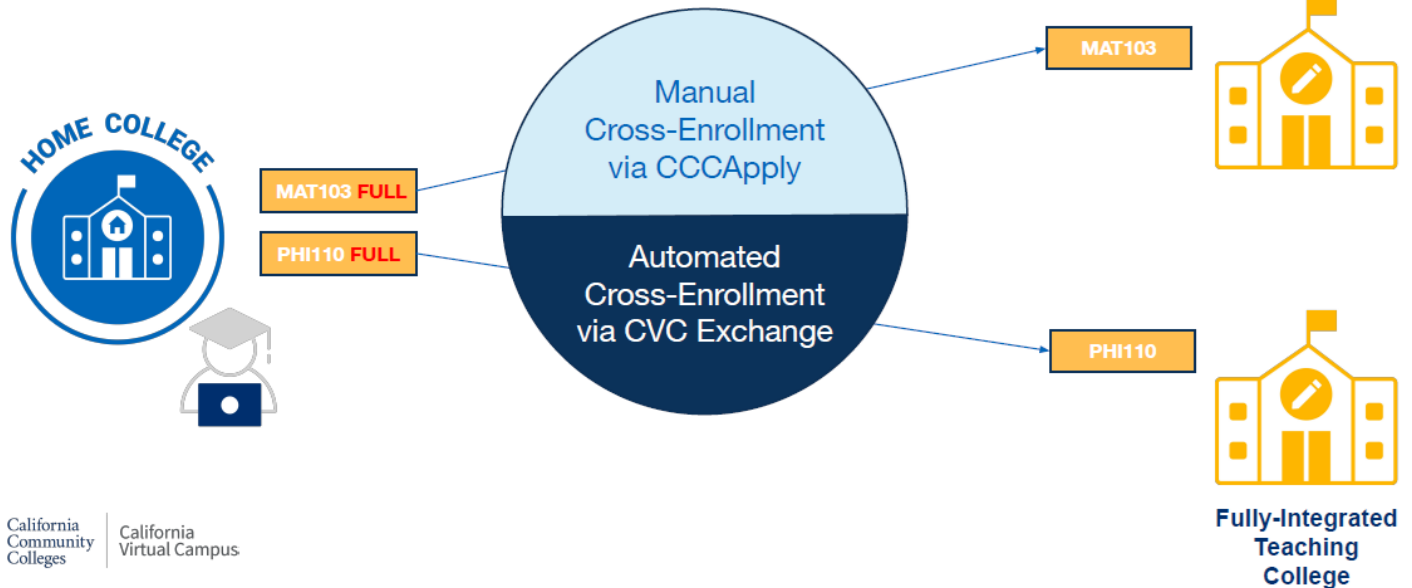
Benefits

- Increases enrollment at the Teaching College

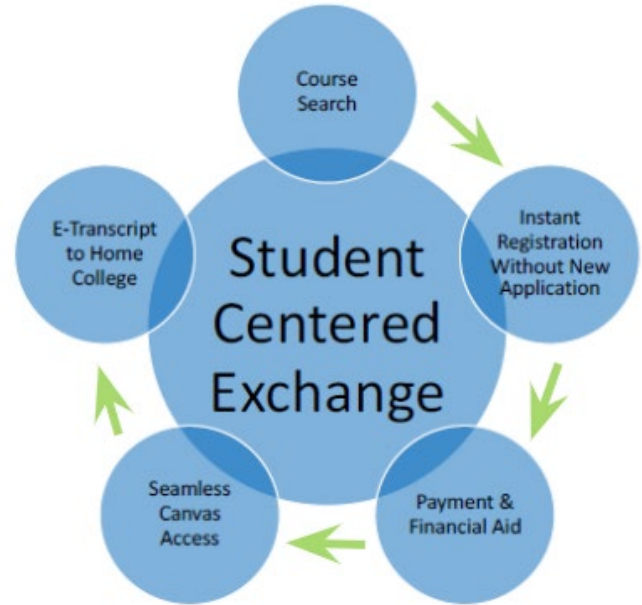
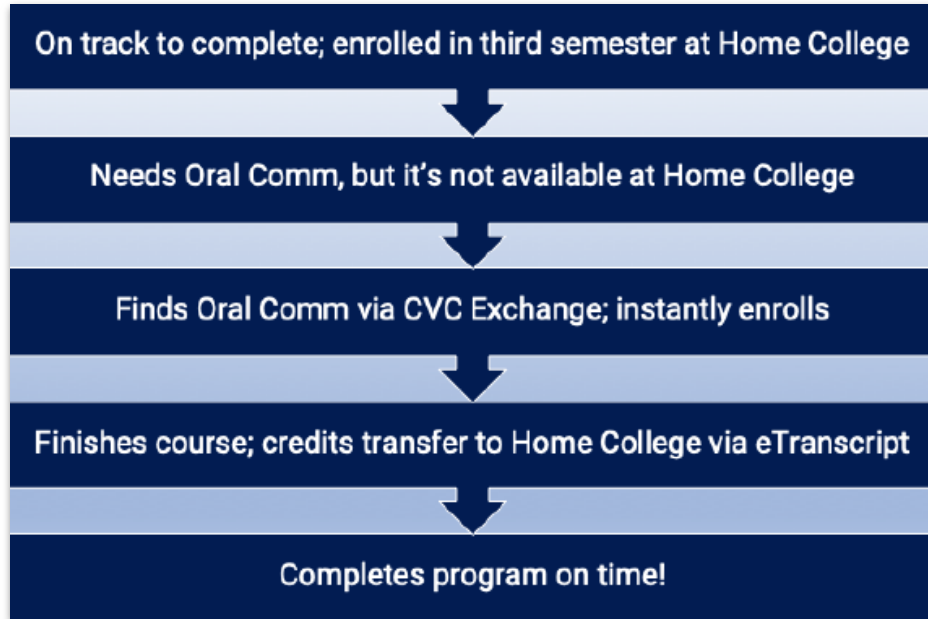

Home & Teaching Colleges

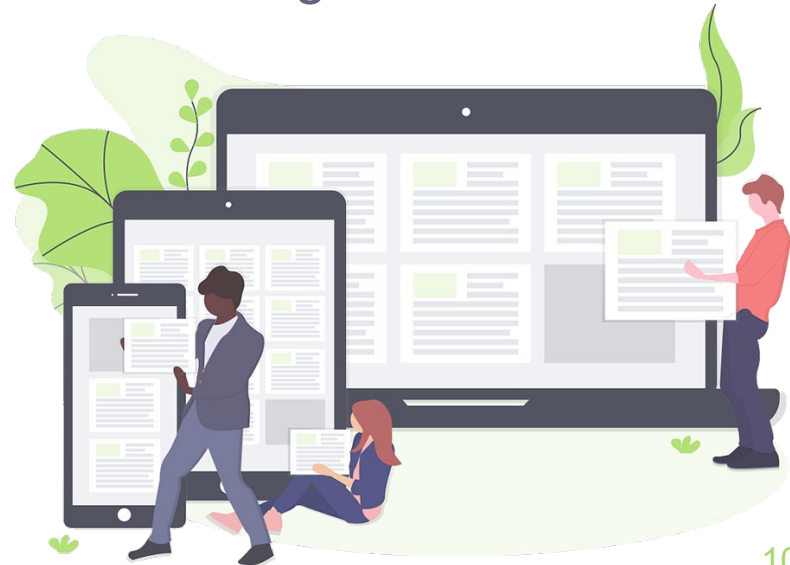


Home Colleges

Chancellor's Office directed all colleges to become home colleges in 2020 (ES 20-27).

Canvas integration displays courses from other colleges on student's home dashboard

- Financial aid & transcript connection
- When student searches the Course Finder, home college's courses are listed first



Who gets what?

When a student takes a course through the CVC Exchange . . .

- The **home college** gets the degree/certificate completion
- The **teaching college** gets FTES for course, as with any student



CCCCO Memo FS 22 07

- Memo sent June 14, 2022
- To apply for the 2022-23 COVID-19 emergency conditions allowance, districts must submit an application to the Chancellor's Office no later than September 1, 2022.
- Funding for district would be approximately \$10.3 million
- Requirements to apply consists of two parts:
 - 1) an Emergency Conditions Recovery Plan, adopted and approved by the local Board of Trustees, and
 - 2) a certification confirming that the district meets specific eligibility requirements.



CCCCO Memo FS 22 07

In addition to the plan, a district must certify:

1. The district will prepare an Emergency Conditions Recovery Plan update to present to their Board of Trustees and furnish a copy of the Board report to the Chancellor's Office no later than February 28, 2023.
2. The district will incentivize and prioritize participation in professional development to enhance quality online teaching and learning (i.e. providing POCR training).



CCCCO Memo FS 22 07

Further requirement for emergency conditions allowance funding

The district:

a. is a member of the CVC-OEI Consortium and has signed the Master Consortium Agreement.

b. by the beginning of the first term that starts on or after January 1, 2023, has implemented the steps to become a Home College and has implemented or committed to
1) enabling Course Finder API, 2) completing the steps needed to become Teaching College ready, and 3) joining a scheduled implementation cohort to become a Teaching College.



CCCCO Memo FS 22 07

- CCCCCO removed previous requirement of local academic senate resolution or statement in support of participation in joining Consortium
- Our district has decided to apply for the emergency conditions allowance funding - which includes joining the Consortium
- I support application as I believe it will benefit our students

CVC Exchange Team Formation -- Suggested Team Makeup

The objective of the *CVC Exchange Team* is to provide cross-departmental participation that informs the development and implementation of processes and technologies at each college related to the services provided by the CVC.
