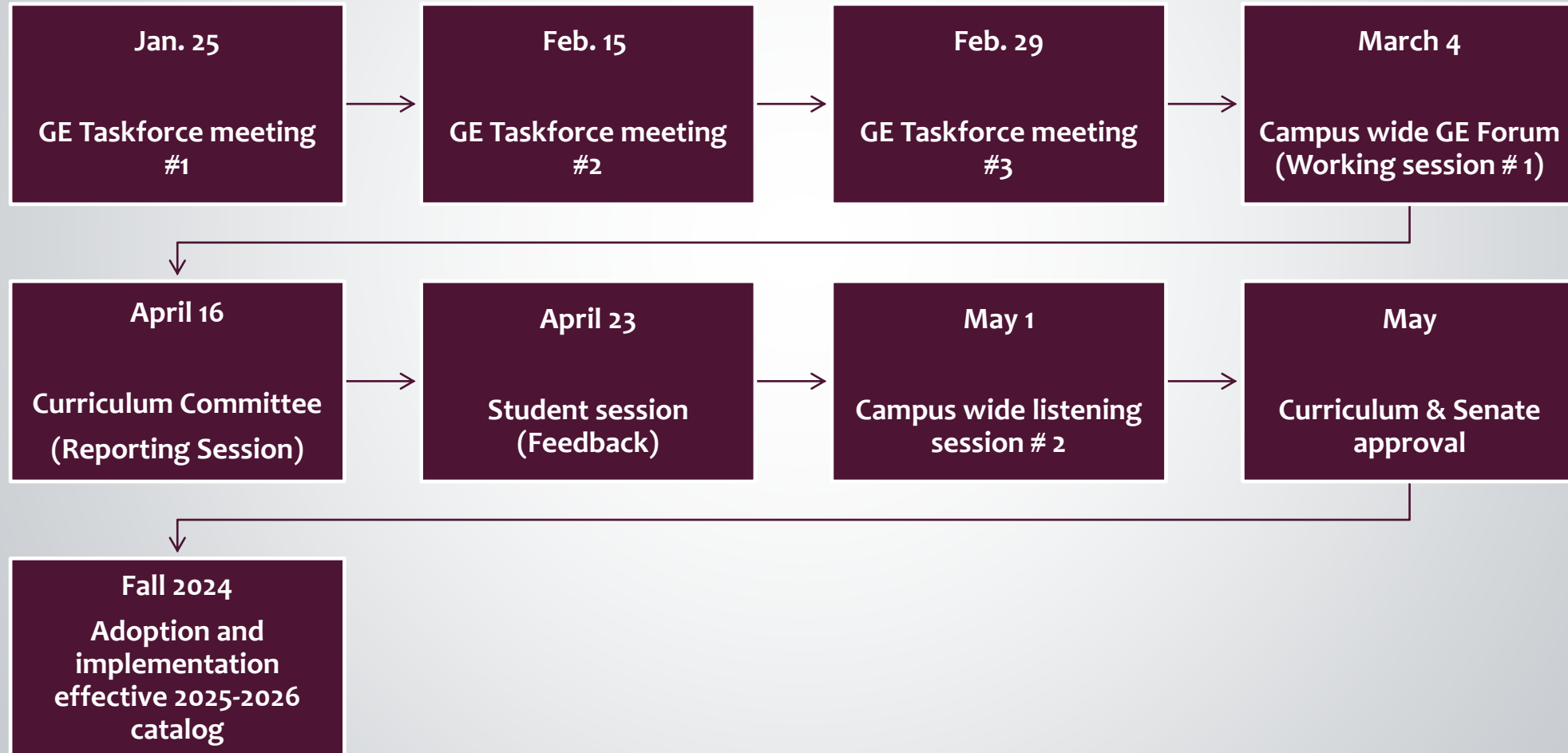

PROPOSAL #1

Taskforce notes on proposal #1

Rationale:

- career/applied education doesn't meet the intent of general education as defined in Title 5
 - “Lifelong Learning” can mean a lot of different things to different people. We are in control of defining the area and the type of courses that are approved for this.
- Repeating another course from Area 3,4, or 5 may feel redundant to students.
- Grossmont's proposed pattern aligns with Proposal 1
