CALL TO ORDER: Manuel Mancillas-Gomez, President called the meeting to order at 2:24pm

I. Approval of Minutes: October 14, 2021 – Senate approve minutes. M/S Sarah Saulter/ Rachel Jacob-Almeida. Senate approves unanimously, no abstentions. **Motion Passes.**

II. Announcements

- A. Next Academic Senate Meeting: Manuel Mancillas-Gomez informed the senate that due to the Thanksgiving holiday, the next Academic Senate meeting will be held on November 04, 2021.
- B. Sabbatical Workshop: Manuel Mancillas-Gomez reminded the senate that sabbatical documents are due next Tuesday, November 02, 2021 by 5PM. As a reminder, only 13 spots were allotted for sabbatical, so this year is going to be a lot more competitive seeing as more people attended the sabbatical workshops than normal.
- C. Other Senator Announcements: Moriah Gonzalez-Meeks informed the senate of the PE (Operational Personnel Hiring) documents that the District Equity in Employment Taskforce has been working on. The draft is almost done and they are requesting feedback on behalf of the Chancellor. More information to come at next meeting.

III. Information (First readings and updates for future action) –

- A. The President's Racial Equity and Social Justice Task Force PD Recommendations: Tacey Hosley reviewed the President's Racial Equity and Social Justice Task Force Professional Development recommendations. Some key observations that came out of this process was that people felt like the current professional development process was heavily focused on faculty and there weren't as many opportunities for classified professionals to engage and there was not necessarily support for adjunct faculty and classified staff to participate. There were a field of Professional Development trainings that worked on aligning with Cuyamaca's Mission, Vision, and Values and by making the recommended changes, it would give Cuyamaca the opportunity to clean up that alignment. Tacey informed that our Professional Development was unsustainable and so Cuyamaca needed to look at restructuring in a way so that we could move forward and get the work done. Reviewed and forwarded for action.
- B. Resource and Operations Council (ROC) Charge and Composition Revision: Manuel Mancillas-Gomez reviewed the revisions made to the Resource and Operations Council Charge and Composition. Manuel informed that the last sentence was revised to better explain how the goals of this council will be achieved. Manuel also let the senate know that this council is in search of a Faculty Co-Chair representative and to reach out to Karen Marrujo if interested. Reviewed and forwarded for action.

Academic Senate Resolution: Manuel Mancillas-Gomez informed the senate that last week, they were approached by a Board Member of Trustee, Linda Cartwright, with some questions and concerns regarding the resolution that Academic Senate presented before the Board. Manuel invited her to the next SOC meeting where they presented our situation and concerns and she will be returning this information to the Board for further discussion.
