

Recommended Revisions for Institutional Learning Outcomes 2019

Developed and Approved by Student Learning Outcome and Assessment Committee February 20, 2019

- <u>Communication Competency</u> Students will communicate information, arguments and opinions effectively to different audiences, though through various modes of communication modalities, including listening, speaking and writing.
- <u>Information Literacy</u> Students will identify, evaluate, and integrate information effectively in various contexts.
- <u>Critical Thinking Competency</u> Students will analyze situations, evaluate options and evaluate qualitative and quantitative information, and synthesize findings to make well justified decisions to make decisions within various contexts.
- <u>Cultural Competency</u> Students will interact effectively with others, talking taking into account their diverse backgrounds, and work well competently in cross-cultural situations.
- **Professional Responsibility** Students will practice ethical and civil conduct in professional environments, as well as resolve conflicts and build alliances.
- <u>Academic and Personal Responsibility</u> Students will set academic goals, use college appropriate resources, and have the knowledge and skills necessary to achieve their goals in a timely manner.
