## RN to BSN transfer reminders:

- An earned Associate's Degree in Nursing from a regionally accredited institution will waive all outstanding requirements except Bible Literature.
- The university can give credit for no more than 70 units from a two-year college or a maximum of 90 units from a four-year institution.
- No course from a two-year or community college can transfer to meet an APU upper division requirement.
- Any course may still be transferable for non-general studies elective units if designated as CSU/UC transferable in the course catalog.
