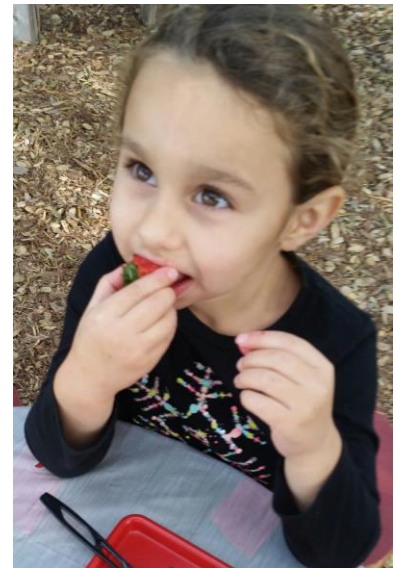
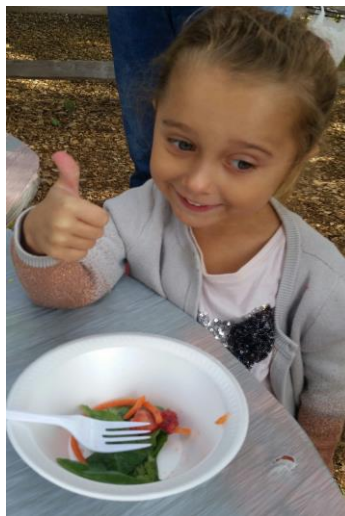

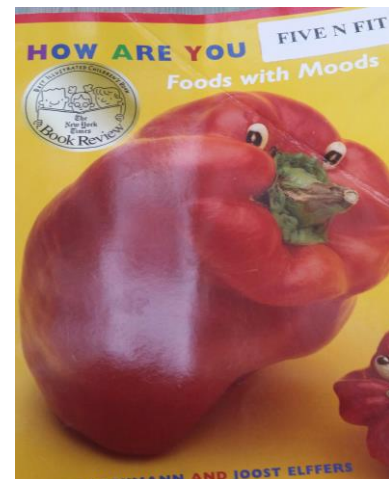
## Morning Glories Garden Newsletter!!!
