You will be guaranteed admission if you have earned a minimum of 35 credits and the California IGETC with a cumulative GPA of 2.5; or earned an associate's degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0.

You will be considered for admission if you have a 2.0 or higher overall college GPA and at least 24 transferable academic college credits.
