

## **TRANSFER GUIDELINES TO COLUMBIA COLLEGE\***

### **General Education**

Columbia College will accept the Cuyamaca College Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degrees with a completed Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) or the California State University General Education (CSU) certificate, as satisfying all of the general education requirements of Columbia College.

Columbia College will accept the Cuyamaca College Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degrees which do not follow the (IGETC) or (CSU) guidelines as meeting Columbia College general education requirements if they include the following:

- ENGL 120 College Composition and Reading with a “C” or higher.
- At least 27 semester hours that meet the Columbia College requirement in the Humanities, Social/Behavioral Sciences and Math/Natural Sciences areas with at least one course in each area.

### **Individual Courses**

Students who do not complete an associate degree or who do not receive a waiver of their general education coursework will be evaluated individually for transfer of credits earned at Cuyamaca College or other accredited institutions by the Evaluations Office at Columbia College, Columbia, Missouri. Upon successful completion, any courses approved in the transfer program taken at Cuyamaca College receiving a “C” or higher will be accepted for transfer to Columbia College. Columbia College will provide a Course Equivalency Guide to Cuyamaca College academic advisors and administrators detailing the course equivalencies.

### **Dual Enrollment**

An Associate’s degree can be completed with Cuyamaca College at any time during the Columbia College bachelor’s degree completion program and still satisfy all the general education requirements of Columbia College. Students are allowed to complete coursework towards the Columbia College general education waiver requirements after their associate’s degree from Cuyamaca College is awarded. Once all the general education waiver requirements are met and the associate’s degree is awarded the student will be eligible for the waiver. Coursework can be completed with Columbia College, Cuyamaca College or other acceptable transfer credit.

### **Credit Hours**

At least 39 hours must be taken at the upper level to receive a bachelor’s degree; the remaining hours can be completed with Columbia College, Cuyamaca College or other transfer work approved by Columbia College. Cuyamaca College students must also complete a minimum 24 of the last 60 semester hours in residency with Columbia College to satisfy the Columbia College residency requirement.
